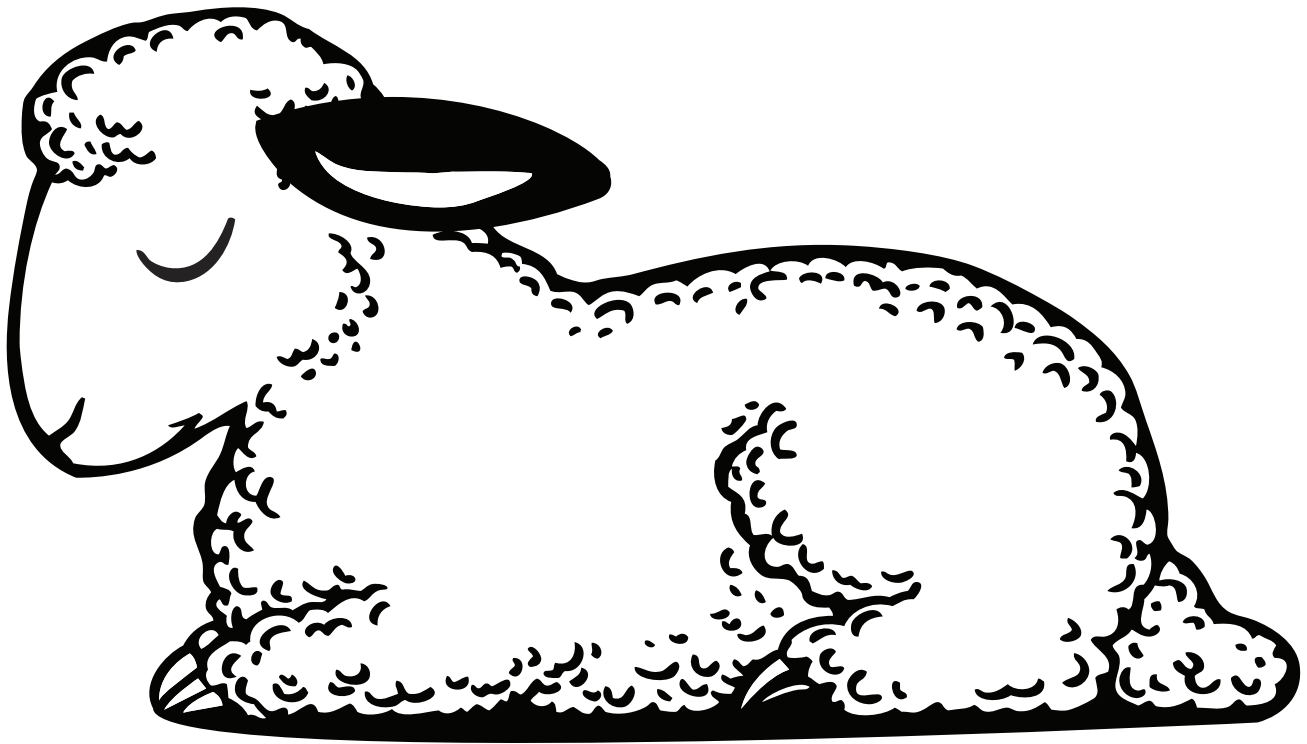


Family Discussion Questions

Psalm 23 Shepherd & the Lamb

1. The Psalms are the Song Book of the Bible. Psalm 23 is a song of love and praise to God that compares God to a loving shepherd who takes care of a flock of sheep. If you were a sheep, who would your human shepherd be?
2. The shepherd gives the sheep everything it needs to eat and drink and also restores its soul. To us, that means giving comfort; making us feel good. What are some words or things that give you comfort?
3. In talking about a rod and staff for the sheep, the Psalm writer is thinking about rules that keep us safe. List some safety rules that keep us from doing things that could harm us.
4. The Psalm talks about the shepherd making the sheep feel safe from enemies. Who or what are your enemies? What makes you feel safe from them?
