**Scripture Lesson / Acts 10: 34-43**

*Our Scripture Lesson this morning is from the tenth chapter of the Acts of the Apostles, verses 34 through 43.*

**Hear these words:**

Then Peter began to speak to them: "I truly understand that God shows no partiality, but in every nation anyone who fears God and does what is right is acceptable to God. This is the message sent by God to the people of Israel, the Good News of peace proclaimed through Jesus Christ—who is Savior of all. That message spread throughout Judea, beginning in Galilee after the baptism that John announced: how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power; how he went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him.

"We are witnesses to all that he did both in Judea and in Jerusalem. They put Jesus to death by hanging him on a tree; but God raised him on the third day and allowed him to appear, not to all the people but to us who were chosen by God as witnesses, and who ate and drank with Christ after he rose from the dead.

"Christ commanded us to preach to the people and to testify that this is the one ordained by God as judge of the living and the dead. To Christ Jesus all the prophets testify, that everyone who believes has forgiveness of sins through this name."
