Scripture Lesson / Matthew 13: 10-17

Our Gospel Lesson this morning is from the 13th chapter of Matthew, verses 10 through 17.

Hear these words:

The disciples came and asked Jesus, "Why do you speak to the people in parables?"

Jesus answered, "To you it has been given to know the secrets of the dominion of heaven, but to them it has not been given. For to those who have, more will be given, and they will have an abundance; but from those who have nothing, even what they have will be taken away.

"The reason I speak to them in parables is that 'seeing they do not perceive, and hearing they do not listen, nor do they understand.' With them indeed is fulfilled the prophecy of Isaiah that says:

'You will indeed listen, but never understand, and you will indeed look, but never perceive. For this people's heart has grown dull, and their ears are hard of hearing, and they have shut their eyes; so that they might not look with their eyes, and listen with their ears, and understand with their heart and turn—and I would heal them.'

"But blessed are your eyes, for they see, and your ears, for they hear. Truly I tell you, many prophets and holy people longed to see what you see, but did not see it, and to hear what you hear, but did not hear it."

This is the Gospel of Hope. Praise to you, Creator, Christ, and Holy Spirit. Amen.
