Here are some things for the family to discuss:

1. Reynardo T. Foxx invited his old friend, Winston Walrus, to his house to discuss old times and watch a video his friend brought along to show him. Name something fun that someone has brought to your house.
2. The video Winston showed was about a Parable Jesus told. A rich man was inviting some of his old friends to come to a big wedding feast. Nobody wanted to go to his party and made excuses about why they were not going to be there. Why do people make up stories about why they can't do something they don't want to do?
3. Some people are afraid to try something new or meet new people because they do not want to change their lives. Why are people afraid to make changes?
4. Winston tells Reynardo that Jesus story is really about God inviting people to share the joy of knowing the kind of love Jesus always lived and taught. Why are people cautious about learning to love everyone else equally?
